## MONASTIC EXPERIENCE WEEKEND

The monastic experience weekend is designed to give single Catholic men aged 18-35 the opportunity to sample monastic life, as it is led at Quarr Abbey in the Benedictine tradition of the Solesmes Congregation.

There is choice in the first reading, the psalm and the gospel in this week's readings – a path of blessing or a path which takes us away from the Lord.

That beautiful psalm, the first in the book, invites us to ground ourselves and root ourselves in God. Listening to God's Law, holding it at the centre of all that we are, anchoring ourselves in him, brings tremendous fruitfulness.

When our roots are planted in him then there is a security, a certain biblical 'happiness'. It doesn't necessarily mean that there is a constant feeling of glee but rather contentedness, blessed-ness. We know ourselves blessed when we anchor ourselves in God. When we realise that life is poor without him, that there is a deep hunger for him, a certain emptiness that only he can heal... then we are blessed because there is room for God.



They will be able to attend the liturgical worship in the church, pursue personal prayer and meditation on the Bible in the prayerful silence of the monastery, and hear talks from the monks about their way of life, their liturgy and the Rule of St Benedict which they follow. There will be opportunities to participate in the work of the monks and to ask questions.
