FAITH IN ACTION

A new award scheme being offered in the Diocese to provide opportunities for young people from the age of 10 upwards to get involved in their parish.

This scheme aims to recognise, reward and celebrated the active faith and service of young people.

This national award is organised by CYMFED to encourage young people to take service into their wider community and accept greater responsibility for their faith in action. The programme facilitates an exploration of scripture and Church teaching, with an emphasis on translating this into action. It encourages young people to shine the light of faith upon their experience of service through guided and personal reflection.

In order for this award scheme to flourish in our parishes we need dedicated adults to facilitate this. If you are interested in getting involved with this award, there are five drop in information sessions (see poster at the back of church) for interested people to see how they could facilitate the scheme in their parish. It is not an onerous commitment but it needs people to drive it.

CAR PARKING

I must remind you again that the top car park is for the residents of Landsdown Place and disabled parishioners, so please do not park there. In addition, we have received significant and justified complaints about Parishioners parking in the private car park of Southfield Veterinary Practice.

Their car park is private, needed for emergencies and absolutely NOT FOR PARISHIONERS TO USE AT ANY TIME.

When I visited them to apologise for the misunderstanding over parking, I was mortified to learned of the rudeness they encountered from our Parishioners when trying to access their own building for veterinary emergencies on Sunday last. I can only ask you to reflect on how you treat people in this area, because they are our neighbours and it's only thanks to their generosity that they haven't taken the matter further.

I know you are keen to know the amount you've raised since September ... all donations, both standing orders and donations total £28,398 - and that doesn't include the gift aid we claim back which should give us an extra £6,000 or so.

If that momentum is continued, it means that we can repay the £80,000 loan we took from the Diocese to do the work, well within three years.

I want to thank you all for such generosity, and that is recognised by many visitors who over the years have remarked on how lovely our Church is, and what a welcoming commu-

nity we have here at St Luke's.
